ORDINANCE NO. 1711 (2024)

ORDINANCE RE-APPROPRIATING \$2,172,344.91 OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A COMMUNITY CENTER, AS MORE FULLY DESCRIBED IN BOND ORDINANCE #1676 (2022), FINALLY ADOPTED FEBRUARY 8, 2022.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEA ISLE CITY, IN THE COUNTY OF CAPE MAY, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that \$2,172,344.91 of the proceeds of obligations originally made available pursuant to the following ordinances of the City of Sea Isle City, in the County of Cape May, New Jersey (the "City") are no longer necessary for the purposes for which the obligations previously were authorized:

Section 2. Said \$2,172,344.91 is hereby re-appropriated to provide for the construction of a Community Center, as more fully described in Bond Ordinance #1676 (2022) of the City, finally adopted February 8, 2022.


Section 3. The City hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget or the City is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
