ORDINANCE NO. 1727 (2025)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SEA ISLE CITY, CHAPTER 7-16.1 ENTITLED "BUS STOPS ESTABLISHED" DESIGNATING BUS STOPS WITHIN THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Sea Isle City shall designate described locations as bus stops in order to establish regulatory compliance and necessary parking and traffic regulations to ensure the safety of motorists and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, the City deems it prudent to remove designated bus stops that are not in use due to buses being unable to traverse the City and to provide additional on street parking until such time as buses are able to traverse the City; and

WHEREAS, the City pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(e) hereby designates bus stops and is permitted to adopt said ordinance pursuant to New Jersey law 39:4-8 b (1); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Sea Isle City, County of Cape May and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION I. Chapter 7 Section 16.1 of the Revised General Ordinances of the City of Sea Isle City, entitled "Bus Stops Established" is hereby amended to delete the following section in its entirety and replace same as follows:

7-16.1 Bus Stops Established.

The following locations are hereby designated and established as bus stops. No vehicle other than an omnibus, picking up or discharging passengers, shall be permitted to occupy said locations at any time:

John F. Kennedy Blvd. North North Bound	Beginning at the easterly curbline of Cini Avenue and extending to a point 105 fee east therefrom.

SECTION II. Severability. If for any reason any section of this Ordinance shall be declared illegal by any Court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining section of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect, notwithstanding.

SECTION III. Repealer. Any Ordinance or provision thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION IV. Publication. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the adoption and publication in accordance with the law.
