

2026 Short Term Parking Permit Regulations

- Short Term Parking Permits cost \$80 per permit.
- Short Term permits shall include vehicle specific information and valid dates shall be face out of the windshield when parked.
- Short Term permits shall be sold in weekly increments with the last day of the last weekly increment to include the eighth day immediately following that increment.
- Parking permits shall be a "hanger" type placard supplied by the City and be hung from the rear-view mirror at all times when the vehicle is parked in a metered spot or lot.
- In the event there is no rear-view mirror, the hanger shall be placed within view behind front windshield on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- If the hanger placard is not properly displayed or not displayed at all the vehicle shall pay the metered fee. There shall be no defense to paying the metered fee if the placard is not displayed as required.
- While some permits are transferable, the resale of any permits is prohibited.
- In the event that a permit is lost or stolen, the replacement charge shall be the full price of the permit.
- Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:3-74 it is unlawful for any person to drive any motor vehicle with the parking permit hanging or obstructing the front windshield.
- Any vehicle with a parking permit properly displayed shall be permitted to park continuously (including overnight) in any parking space except the Library Parking Lot and 15 minute metered parking limit spaces. The Library Parking Lot and 15 minute metered parking limit spaces shall be strictly followed; no exception shall be made for the parking of permitted vehicles.
- Permits are subject to any temporary emergency or other parking restrictions in any street or lot and shall comply with same.
