#### 2) Ordinance No. 1626 (2018) Master Plan Consistency Review

To amend revise General Ordinances of City of Sea Isle City amending Chapter 26 entitled "Zoning" to add 26-43, et seq., entitled "Affordable Housing" and amending the zones and zoning map to address the requirements of the New Jersey Superior Court

<u>Professionals:</u> City Board Engineer explains the affordable housing obligations as far as the definitions, fees, standards, regulations, and the City Appointed Municipal Liaison. He also discusses some of the zoning changes from R-2 and C-2 to R-3 (which is Age Restricted Residential & addressed via separate ordinance), in addition to the overlay inclusionary zone in certain C-2 and C-3 zones.

<u>Board Comment</u>: there is question to possible ownership of lots within the area of zone changes discussed Public Comment: None

Planning Board recommendation that Ordinance 1626 is NOT INCONSISTANT with the Master Plan, with changes as indicated by Mr. Batastini and C-3 -Block 37.07 Lot 19 be R-2; Mr. Bonifazi makes motion, Mr. Baldini seconds, roll call of those eligible to vote - aye 4 in favor / none opposed (1 recused/2 abstained)

#### 3) Ordinance No. 1627 (2018) Master Plan Consistency Review

To amend revise General Ordinances of City of Sea Isle City amending Chapter 26 entitled "Zoning" to create age-restricted zone, add an inclusionary housing overlay district and add a mandatory affordable housing set aside provision

<u>Professionals:</u> City Board Engineer defines R-3 -Age Restricted Residential and IZ -Inclusionary Housing Overlay Districts explaining the development vs. deposit into affordable house trust fund option. He continues with details about incentives for developers like payment in a set amount instead of actual unit development and the associated requirements to help assist in fulfilling this housing obligation

<u>Board Comment</u>: interest or future increases in the per unit dollar amount established if trust fund deposit is selected in lieu of development is discussed

#### Public Comment: None

Planning Board recommendation is that Ordinance 1627 is NOT INCONSISTANT with the Master Plan, with comments of R-2 included in Replacement section 26-12.2 & 26-43.3A and comments as discussed, and unanimously agreed that Planning Board should review and provide recommendations for R3 bulk standards and layout of regulations on housing; Mr. Ferrilli makes motion, Mr. Baldini seconds, roll call of those eligible to vote - aye 5 in favor / none opposed (2 abstained)

# 4) Ordinance No. 1628 (2018) Master Plan Consistency Review

To amend revise General Ordinances of City of Sea Isle City amending Chapter 26 entitled "Zoning" to add non-residential affordable housing development fees

<u>Professionals:</u> City Board Engineer reviews non-residential fee where approximately 2.5% of increase in equalized assessed value of land and improvements, within all zoning districts, will be imposed on development fees when an existing structure is demolished / replaced and collected at time of any issuance of building permit

<u>Board Comment</u>: temp CO issue had not been addressed yet; funds said to be maintained by a City Financial Officer Public Comment: None

Planning Board recommendation is that Ordinance 1628 is NOT INCONSISTANT with the Master Plan; Mr. Baldini makes motion, Mr. Bonifazi seconds, roll call of those eligible to vote - aye 5 in favor / none opposed (2 abstained)

#### ~Meeting Minutes to adopt:

Regular Meeting Minutes of October 9, 2018 adopted. Mr. Ferrilli makes motion, Mr. Bonifazi seconds, roll call those eligible to vote - aye all 5 in favor / none opposed

Mention of items discussed at last meeting for Council to address, along with information provided by Mr. Previti regarding parking for Hotels/Motels and data from surrounding municipalities for reference are talked about, as well as residential pools and surrounds and water run-off especially since there are so many of them coming before the Zoning Board. There was further question to whether a letter was ever sent to Council in the first place. In closing, the Master Plan having been approved by the Planning Board is now seeking to have some of the problem items addressed and resolved in some way.
