#### 2) LIST OF ITEMS PLANNING BOARD WOULD LIKE COUNCIL TO REVIEW

- a. it should be required that exterior material on all new construction be fire retardant in order to take any and all steps possible to keep fires from spreading to other structures since sprinkler systems cannot be required
- b. provide specific requirements for swimming pool and pool surround as far as pervious coverage and maintaining water run-off, and being addressed as an accessory structure because there are no regulations for pools right now
- c. commercial side yard setbacks @ 4' minimum or more for fire access and safety and maintenance access
- d. commercial & residential landscaping requiring a form of guarantee or bond for minimum of three (3) years to insure landscaping is being kept up
- e. residential condensing units being put on roof top was brought up due to corner units not having enough space around lower lever of structure for a platform to place units on above flood level, in addition to not being allowed if they cannot be screened right or have access for maintenance
- f. parking being squeezed into areas as shown on plans that is not sufficient turning radius for a car nor a realistic parking space with actual driver access
- g. parking in side yards has become an issue, as well as create conflict amongst neighbors, which is believed to have a need of being addressed and limited in some way
- h. three (3) phase electrical services should be required to run underground, which was brought about by horrible transformer boxes in the middle of the sidewalk in Townsend Inlet, that someone should have required to have located on the applicant's property and the Electric Company should not have had a right to place them in the right-of-way at all
- i. a useless point though previous voted on, even though information provided reflects surround areas parking requirements different from ours and Sea Isle City being non-sufficient for mixed use development
