Please Note: ALL VEHICLES MUST BE OFF THE BEACH BETWEEN 9:00 AM AND 5:00 PM DAILY from April 30th to May 15th

This fishing permit decal must be displayed to a stationary/immovable side or rear window on the driver's side of the vehicle.

This numbered permit **MUST** be displayed at all times when you are fishing on the beach.

ENTER THE BEACH AT YOUR OWN RISK

FOR FISHING NORTH OF 31ST STREET Enter/Exit at 22nd St

FOR FISHING SOUTH OF 57TH STREET Enter/Exit at 75th or 85th St

DO NOT USE THE RAMPS LOCATED AT 29TH OR 57TH STREET

NO VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED SOUTH OF 94TH STREET FROM APRIL 1ST TO May 15th

**** IMPORTANT: ****

Due to the adoption of the City's new Beach Management Plan, **NO VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED IN THE "PROTECTED ZONES"** from MARCH 15TH THRU MAY 15TH. There are two (2) protected zones: **NORTH ZONE**: – 1st Street to 20th Street and **SOUTH ZONE**: 93rd Street South to the Townsend Inlet Bridge. There are **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

SURF FISHING

Fishing may be done on the beaches between 31st and 57th Street – **BUT NO VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED**

No vehicles are permitted on Upper Township Beaches (Strathmere)

Dear Applicant:


September 15th is just a short distance away; it is the date that Sea Isle City permits driving on the beach in a Four Wheel Drive vehicle for fishing only. Along with this privilege come responsibilities. Please observe beach permit rules and courtesies designed for the safety and enjoyment of beachgoers and beach area residents.

 Please use approved beach entrances and exists only. For fishing north of 31st Street enter & exit at 22nd Street. For fishing South of 57th Street enter & exit at 75th Street or 85th Street.


 Please obey our 10 **mph speed limit**. Our residents and visitors enjoy the beach all through the fall. Be mindful of their safety.

 Please be courteous to your neighbors and **DO NOT idle your vehicle at the beach entrance**. Noise carries farther in early morning and late evening and idling vehicles can be disturbing to residents near the beach entrances.

 While surf fishing is permitted between 31st and 57th Street, please remember that **NO vehicles are allowed in that area**.

 Be aware that the Sea Isle City Police Department will be patrolling the beach more often than usual. Your fishing permit decal must be displayed to a stationary/immovable side or rear window on the driver's side of the vehicle.

 Please remember to check the 2022 New Jersey Minimum Size and Possession Limits. We wish you a safe and plentiful fishing season.
