WHAT

Cardboard & Paper, Plastic, Metal and Glass - all placed loosely in **ONE** Recycling Container.

Cardboard & Paper: Newspapers with inserts, office paper (no shredded paper), junk mail, empty cardboard, magazines, telephone and paperback books, gift, shoe and tissues boxes, dry food boxes (remove all liner bags), beer and soda carriers and non-foil wrapping paper. **CLEAN** pizza boxes – throw soiled parts of the box in trash and recycle the clean part!

Plastic: Plastic bottles, jars, jugs and containers: food, beverage, health and beauty. All containers are to be empty and clean with all caps and lids removed.

Metal: Food and beverage cans: aluminum or steel (tin) with all lids removed.

Glass: Food and beverage glass containers with all lids removed: clear, green or brown bottles, jars and jugs.

MUST BE BROUGHT TO THE CMCMUA LANDFILL

Antifreeze, motor oil, used oil filters, kerosene, contaminated soil and propane tanks (\$7 per tank).

ITEMS THAT ARE ACCEPTED AT THE RECYCLE DROP OFF AREA (RDOA)

Beach chairs, metal scraps, printers, stereos, television sets, computers, shredders, clean wood pallets and crates, grass clippings, tree branches and stumps, and Christmas trees.

HOW

Please place all items in a rigid, reusable container with a detached lid not to exceed 50 lbs. or a 35-gallon can curbside prior to 6am of your pick-up day. Plastic bags are not to be placed curbside. **Do not place recyclables in plastic bags for collection.** Household trash is not to be placed in public trash containers.

DO NOT RECYCLE

Shredded paper, food-contaminated boxes, Styrofoam packaging, polystyrene egg cartons, wax-coated cardboard boxes, window glass, plastic drinking cups, mixed and bulky rigid plastics (non-flexible plastics), paint cans, PVC pipes, light bulbs, plastic bags or any items that contain chemical or hazardous products.

RECYCLE DROP OFF AREA (RDOA)

Location: 401 JFK Blvd. (West of the DPW Yard), **Year-round Hours:** 7:15am-2:45pm

Holidays: Closed (*except New Year's Day, Presidents Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day and Labor Day.*)

TRASH & RECYCLING SCHEDULE

Summer (begins Memorial Day)

1st to 44th street	Wednesday & Saturday
45th to 70th street	Monday & Thursday
71st to 94th street	Tuesday & Friday

Winter (begins 3rd Monday of September)

1st to 44th street	Wednesday
45th to 70th street	Monday
71st to 94th street	Tuesday

Light metals and are picked up curbside year-round.

BULK TRASH AND BRUSH (OCTOBER THROUGH MAY)

1st to 44th street	1st Thursday of each month
45th to 70th street	2nd Thursday of each month
71st to 94th streets	3rd Thursday of each month
Brush	4th Thursday of each month

4th Thursday in May & 4th Thursday in September
